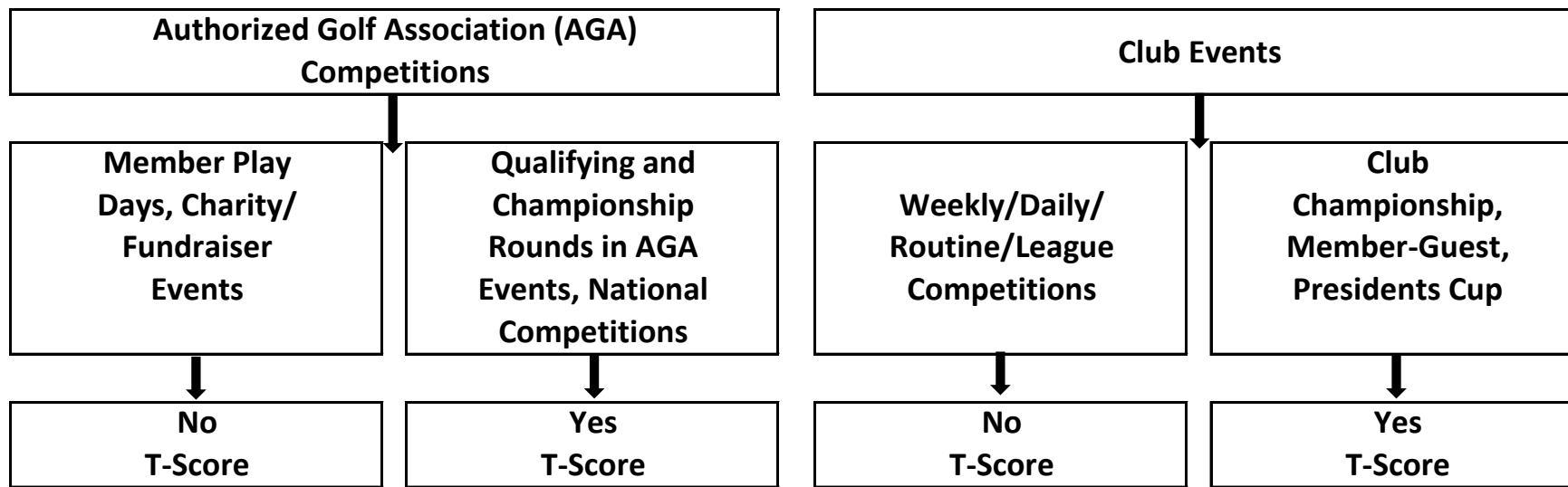


Tournament Scores

Suggested per the USGA Handicap System



A 'tournament score' (T-Score) is a score made in a competition organized and conducted by the Committee in charge of the competition. The competition must identify a winner(s) based on a stipulated round(s), and must be played under 'The Rules of Golf'

The Committee in Charge of the competition must announce in advance whether the score is to be designated as *Tournament Scores*. For example, club events that are routine events such as daily, weekly, or monthly play should not be designated a *Tournament Scores*.

Reference: *USGA Handicap System Manual sections 4-1 and 4-2*

- Post most likely score for holes started but not completed
Conceded strokes (match play) partner out of a hole (weekly play)
- **Most likely score is:**
Number of strokes already taken plus strokes estimated to complete the hole (do not exceed allotted handicap strokes)
- Holes not played under the 'Rules of Golf' *Mulligans - Magic Putts - Pro Hits - Holes not finished, not played under the Rules of Golf (13 for 18 hole game & 7 holes for 9 - hole game)*
- **Post par plus handicap for each hole not played**
Answer is: If you play, you must post!
